

## Premiers update Monday 27 April 2020

---

Hi all

- **Stay Home, Save Lives** remains the key message from the Tasmanian Government.
- Another four cases in Tas - total for the state 212. All new cases were in the NW.
- Testing is available - anyone with any symptoms or concern - get tested, especially if you are in the NW.
- Acknowledgment of the efforts of the community in following the rules.
- There have sadly been more deaths over the weekend, bringing the states total deaths from COVID 19 to 11. Both from the NW.
- An independent review into the NW situation will be undertaken at some appropriate point in the future (probably before the pandemic is over, but not when it will interfere with the important work currently being done).
- The pathway to recovery - will be a slow and gradual process.
  - Tasmania will be making its own decision that may be different from other states, due to the increased level of vulnerability in the Tas population.
  - NW outbreak needs to be under control.
  - Tas will continue to have as much testing as possible.

- NOTE: the app will not protect you, so continuing social distancing and hygiene measures remain in place.
